Volunteers/Champions

- Champions have undertaken Talk Cancer training, increasing their confidence in how to talk and listen to people affected by cancer.
- We currently have eight active Champions having successfully recruited three more. All inductions and training are complete.
- We have four Research Champions, two of which are also Healthwatch Champions. All necessary training is complete.
- Champions' quarterly supervision sessions and annual satisfaction survey have been carried out.
- One Champion has been involved in Gateshead's strategic volunteering overview named 'Helping Out'.

Outreach

- From 11 January to date we have carried out three events have taken place since
 January: Chinese New Year (outdoors), Time to Talk Day (Gateshead Job Centre) and
 International Women's Day (Gateshead Interchange). Two focus groups have taken place
 since mid-January, falling short of our two per month target due to Champion
 recruitment and training, annual leave, sickness and capacity.
- Participated in the Sir Robert Francis visit by hosting a focus group at the Angelou Centre in Newcastle.
- Assisted in arrangements for Healthwatch annual conference to be held on 24 April.
- Relationship with International Women's Day organiser has progressed to the possibility of Gateshead Council hosting a men's health event during November, known as Movember. There has not been a Movember event held in Gateshead previously.

Feedback centre

- We are not on track to achieve the Committee KPIs for feedback centre reviews, despite valiant efforts in order to do so.
- We envisage this will increase when the Ambassador role is rolled out, as the emphasis of the role is to raise the profile of Healthwatch.

Going forward

- We are looking to create a new Ambassador role across both areas, with the Committees'
 agreement once the Research Champion role is embedded, possibly around the Summer
 time of 2019.
- Our geographical monitoring shows us we still need to undertake more work in the east and far west of the borough. We are currently mapping outreach activities in these areas.
- One of the areas we would like to prioritise in the coming months is gathering the views of people who use drug and alcohol services.
