## **Volunteers/Champions**

- Joint Champions meetings with Healthwatch Newcastle are held every eight weeks.
- Champions have agreed to undertake Gateshead Public Health's Making Every Contact Count (MECC) training. This enables Champions to confidently signpost and encourage people, friends, family, neighbours, community members, etc. to access any early or brief intervention services. This has all been finalised, training is due to commence November and December.
- We sadly lost a Champion in August which was very sudden and a shock to her family too.
- Five out of six Champions are active, and we need more support so we are actively recruiting more Champions. Initially this will mainly be done by word of mouth, social media and an article in the next newsletter. Part of this will include the internal and external recruitment of Research Champions.
- Champions have undergone Professional Boundaries training and Cultural Awareness training recently.

## Outreach

- From 1 April to 30 September 2018 we have carried out 24 engagement activities, two large regional events, the Mela and Newcastle Pride, two stalls and four focus groups, two of which were specific to our project work on funding for social care.
- We have made very good progress with Roma communities. Roma community leaders are meeting with four local Practice Managers in November and are now linked to the Health and Race Equality Forum (HAREF).
- We will be attending more family and young people's settings, i.e. Rhymetime, school family support workers.

#### Feedback centre

• The last date of the incentivised £25 prize draw was 31 August. The Committee will be taking a decision on whether this should be continued at this meeting.

#### Going forward

- We have made inroads to Gateshead College for us to have a regular slot with health and social care students.
- We have made initial contact with the only youth worker left in Gateshead, with a view to establishing some sustained engagement directly with youth groups and young people.
- We are also trying to meet with school Family Support Workers.
- Work on engagement with black, Asian and minority ethnic communities is still being planned. We are gathering contacts and making approaches via established networks and relationships.
- More work needs to be carried out in the West of Gateshead (see map).

•	More work needs to be carried out at other care and health settings, i.e. dentists, opticians. Both these groups are proving difficult to infiltrate so we feel that the best approach would be to concentrate on the views of young people and BAME communities, while trying to develop links with these settings across Gateshead and Newcastle.
